NOTES

Food Safety

- Larger sites may provide hot or cold food as part of welfare arrangements.
- All food must be stored, handled and prepared in hygienic conditions.
- Anyone preparing food for others must observe good standards of personal hygiene, not smoke in food preparations areas and report certain illnesses.
- Where a cooker or microwave oven is provided for you to prepare your own food ensure the food is thoroughly cooked – undercooked food can lead to food poisoning.
- Dispose of waste food safely. Do not encourage rat or other vermin.
