Security on Site

NOTES

- Check that the perimeter hoarding or fencing is intact and is to a standard which does not encourage unauthorized entry.
- Remove keys from plant and equipment when not in use.
- Remove from view and secure any tools, equipment and materials which might tempt thieves onto the site after normal working hours.

Q: How can you remove the temptation for children to play on scaffold and in excavations?

Dealing with trespassers

- Ask suspected trespassers who they wish to see and if necessary, escort them to site security. If they are genuine visitors, they will not mind being challenged.
- Ensure that trespassing children are escorted off the site immediately.
- Do not put yourself in a position where you could be accused of assault.
